### Today's Program...

Jennifer Martin spoke to us about The Education Project, which is a project of the Washtenaw intermediate School District. The objective is to ensure that students experiencing homelessness or temporary living conditions are able to enroll, regularly attend and succeed in school. Jennifer said that there are over 1300 students in this category in Washtenaw County including over 300 in the Ann Arbor Public School District. WISD works with all 10 school districts in the county and well as 9



charter schools. The services provided include advocacy, transportation services, school supplies, case management, housing crisis assistance, clothing and holiday gift giving. WISD works with other area non-profits including Ozone House, IHN, SOS Community Services and Safe House. 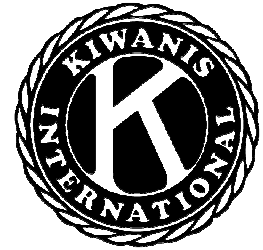

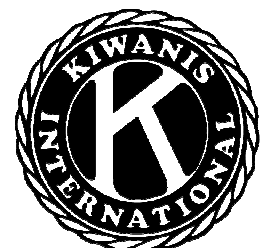

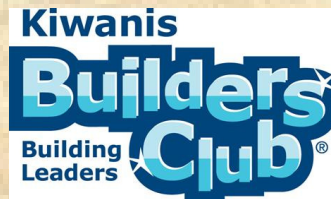
