Jim Huck introduced Belinda Dulin, Executive Director of the Dispute Resolution Center (DRC), a local non-profit agency whose goal is to help resolve conflicts peacefully in a confidential, professional, affordable, accessible, non-threatening way. To that end the DRC, under the auspices of the Michigan Supreme Court, provides substantive training for volunteers who act as neutral third parties to

facilitate conflict resolution through mediation, facilitation, conciliation, restorative practices, and peacemaking in Washtenaw and Livingston counties. Clients may be families facing divorce, custody, or caregiving issues, students having conflicts with fellow students or teachers, or parents with conflicts with their teens or school personnel. Clients may also be neighbors, landlords and tenants, consumers, and employers and employees with disputes. Clients can self-refer or may be referred by one of several partner organizations including local courts, bar associations, schools, and law enforcement agencies. Ms. Dulin said that the objective is that there not be winners and losers but that conflicts be resolved to the parties' mutual satisfaction and that the parties follow through to implement the resolutions they reach. In 2014, over 1,000 people utilized DRC services. Fees for services range from \$30 to \$300, but can be waived in appropriate situations. 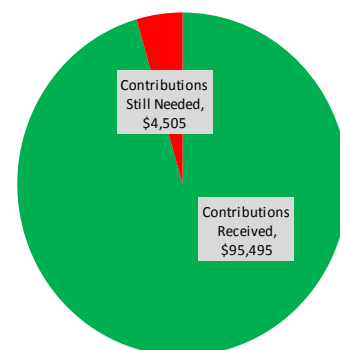
