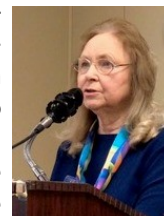

The Name of the Game

Gerry lived alone and was virtually blind, but was unquestionably a leader. I met him while in my twenties at a JC's meeting. Gerry lived alone, virtually blind, self reliant and was unquestionably a great man.

In his seventy years of a full life, fifty of them were spent serving his community as a Kiwanian and serving like very few ever will. When asked why he was so committed to service he said "People have helped me all of my life, and I'm simply trying to pay them back. Helping people is the name of the game."

Gerry had an uncanny memory. He remembered minute details of everything. He could recite phone numbers, addresses, dates and locations. He couldn't write things down, so it was all in his mind.

I would see Gerry walking down the street or waiting on a bus, often times in inclement weather and would pull over, roll down the window and say "Hey Gerry want a lift?" He would jump in and talk non-stop about Kiwanis or the Tigers. One time when we got to his destination, I said "Gerry, here you are". Thinking he did not hear me I said louder "Gerry, here you are". Gerry fires back "Bob, I'm blind not DEAF" with a hearty laugh. He was one of kind.

Last week we lost that uncanny mind and it will be impossible to replace his spirit and love of all people. Why am I telling you this story? I guess for me, I just wanted to hear his name said one more time.
