Travel for Seniors

Deb Jones introduced today's speaker, Virginia Davis from Main Street Travel of Dexter. Ms. Davis has over 20 years experience in the travel industry and provided an overview of some interesting U.S. travel options that are a bit different. She focused on rail travel packages, steamboat river cruises, and Great Lakes cruises.

There are numerous rail vacation packages available in the U.S. (on Amtrak) and in Canada (on Via Rail)—who knew? These can be fairly simple or as elaborate as your budget allows. An example is the Glacier National Park Express. 10 days/9 nights one-way on the Empire Builder from Chicago to Glacier National Park to Seattle.

Along the way you'll enjoy side tours and stay in a historic railway lodge dating from the late 19th century. Current cost for this trip is \$2,499 per person/double occupancy.

Maybe a steamboat river cruise is more to your liking? The American Queen Steamboat Company offers trips on the Mississippi, Ohio, Tennessee, Cumberland, Illinois, Columbia, and Snake Rivers. Accommodations range from luxury suites to basic state-rooms. Tour fares include on-board meals and beverages, shore excursions, entertainment, lectures, and themed events. One of their longer cruises is *The Mighty Mississippi*—a 16 day cruise from Minneapolis to New Orleans starting at \$4,999 per person/double occupancy.

Great Lakes cruising is making a comeback and Alexander+Roberts offers one of the best tours. The *mv Victory I* carries only 202 passengers with a staff of 80. You can enjoy fine accommodations and dining on a ten day cruise from Chicago to Toronto. Along the way there are stops and side trips at Mackinac Island, Manitoulin Island, Killbear Park, The Henry Ford Museum, The Rock & Roll Hall of Fame, and Niagara Falls. As Virginia said, this tour is a bit dear starting at \$5,699 per person/double occupancy.
