Dexter Public Schools, creative principal and educator, Craig McCalla and Ryan Bruder, respectively. The sobering facts: Michigan ranks 41st in the nation in fourth-grade reading achievement; we're 49th in African American students. McCalla and Bruder are dedicated to preventing the Summer Slide where students spend less than 10 minutes a day in reading. "The key is having family members sitting down with them to read: parents, grandparents, brothers and sisters."

Dexter offers a number of summer literacy-reading workshops. But they hope to establish a mobile Bookmobile that would service the community similar to programs in Saline and Chelsea. And, they are looking to Kiwanis to supply books "to get them to the students." Their proposed Bookmobile program:

1. Visit four high density neighborhoods and downtown;
2. Set dates so that families are aware of their visits and the location downtown;
3. Share with other communities; and
4. Foster love of books.

"We want to spread this program and share with our neighbors in Washtenaw County," McCalla and Bruder said in summary. The Q and A session that followed their remarks showed a strong interest in their program from club members.

**A Thanksgiving Recipe from Dale's Kitchen**

**Grandma E's Homemade Buns**

2 Eggs  
1 Cup Sugar  
4 teaspoons Salt  
2 Tablespoons Shortening

Beat the above ingredients with mixer until fluffy.

Put 3 packages yeast in 1/2 Cup warm water plus 1 Tablespoon sugar. Let set until real bubbly - add to the above ingredients. Add 2 more cups warm water, mix well.

Add 8-10 Cups flour - knead well (mixer).

Grease dough well, put in bowl and let rise one hour. Press air out of dough.

Shape into buns, let rise one more hour.

Bake at 325 degrees for 18 minutes. While warm, coat tops of buns with butter.
