TODAY'S PROGRAM...

Leuk's Landing

Emily Allshouse (a cat lover) introduced our speaker Leona Foster, Founder of Leuk's Landing. Leona was assisted by Leuk's Landing volunteer Donna Johnson. Leuk's landing is a local non-profit founded eleven years ago to provide a permanent home for kitties with serious illnesses.

Leuk's is a euphemism for feline leukemia which is an immune system disease in cats (like aids). It is communicable and found, primarily, among cats who live outdoors. It can also be passed along to kittens at birth. Cats who test positive can be without symptoms for months or even years. However, they must be separated from other cats to prevent the spread of disease. There is no cure for the disease but symptoms (infections) can be treated. Leona purchased a two car garage and made it into a comfortable shelter for kitties. They currently provide a home for 39 cats with 23 others in foster care. They are one of 16 certified shelters in Michigan. U-M Circle K members volunteer at the shelter and some provide foster care. Leuk's Land-
