### TODAY'S PROGRAM...

#### U-M Football Preview with Jim Brandstatter

**Jim Carey** introduced our speaker Jim Brandstatter, former UM Football all Big Ten and renowned sports broadcaster. Brandstatter was a three-year letter winner and played in two Rose Bowls under coach Bo Schembechler. He is in both the State of Michigan Sports and Sports Broadcasting Halls of Fame. He has 40 years experience in sports broadcasting.

Jim started his talk by congratulating our club for its great community service, a wonderful facility and a fine lunch. Following an Ohio State joke, he turned to current events, recounting a June phone call he made to WJR radio offering to extend his Detroit Lions broadcasting contract. He was told WJR had decided to go in a different direction, to which he responded "Wow" and hung up. Upon reflection and discussion with spouse Robbie Timmons, he is thankful for a good 31 year run with Lions Football on WJR and the fact that he will now have his life back in August and December (and finally have a Christmas at home).

Turning to UM Football, he noted that he often hears two words, "Shea Patterson," one of this season's quarterback hopefuls. He noted that coach Jim Harbaugh is a great quarterback coach who believes in "building calluses" as a means of becoming a tougher, better player and making continual improvement. Jim noted Harbaugh's coaching of former quarterbacks Jake Ruddock and Wilton Speight as examples. While the quarterback is a key position, Brandstatter believes that the offensive line, especially quarterback protection, is also key. He also touted the surprise factor of using a roaming "viper" position on defense.

Jim believes that the Big 10 conference is very strong with several top teams and therefore a tough regular season schedule. Again he notes that Jim Harbaugh has done a great job of branding UM football globally, noting his gift of a Michigan football helmet to the Pope. He also believes that winning rival games will drive this year's team. Hats off to sports legend Jim Brandstatter and GO BLUE!

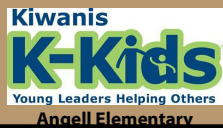

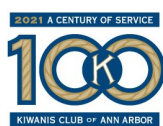
