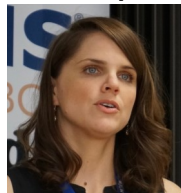

#### SAV Hospitality: The Dixboro House Restaurant

**Emily Allshouse** introduced us to today's speaker, Bree Stillwell, a Wayne State graduate whose experience includes ten years in the Napa Valley wine industry, and the current Marketing and Business Development Director for SavCo. SavCo is the company behind Ann Arbor's SAVA and Aventura restaurants and also offers catering through their company Tavolina.

Bree comes to us today to speak about their upcoming plans to renovate and reopen the restaurant known to many as the former Lord Fox. Located on seven acres of beautiful creekside property, this building has over 100 years of history as a restaurant and SavCo plans to keep that history alive, while bringing their own special touch.

CEO Sava Lelcaj-Farah was excited to purchase the Dixboro property when it came up for sale, believing it had so much more potential. As noted, this building sits along the Fulmer Creek so the possibilities are endless. Being in the beginning stages, Bree gave some history and ideas being discussed and then opened the floor for a question and answer session. We

learned that the property will be renovated, highlighting the history of the location, while also creating a casual, yet unique, experience that will welcome all. Food will be locally sourced and the menu will include meat, vegetarian, vegan and gluten free choices. They're also thinking about takeout pizza that can be enjoyed at a table along the creek and a playground area for kids. Out of respect for their neighbors and the natural setting, they don't plan on having an "events" space at this time. They're also working with the Huron River Watershed Council to develop the property in a way to protect the environment and remove invasive species from the area. Bree's enthusiasm and the work SavCo is doing not only with the new restaurant but also with the surrounding property is very exciting and we all look forward to visiting once the project is finished.

Thank you, Bree, for entertaining us with the history of and future plans SavCo has for the Dixboro property. We'll mark our calendars for the opening in April of 2019 and, if you're looking for volunteers for a soft opening, you know where to find some!

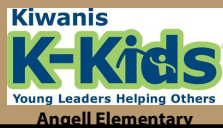

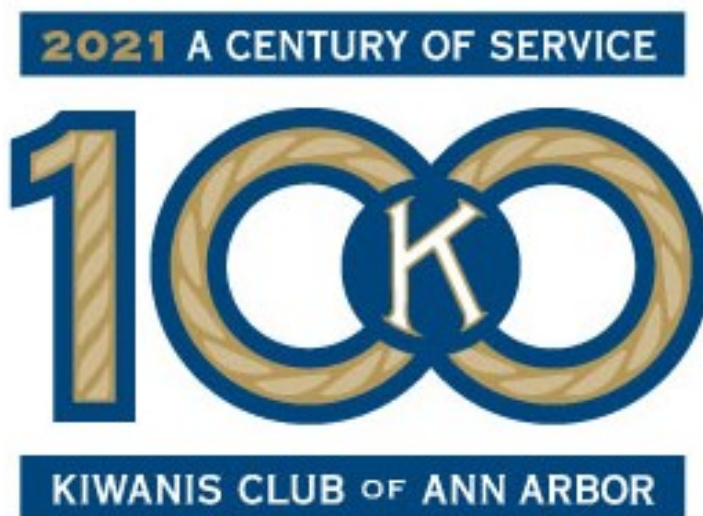
