TODAY'S PROGRAM...

Reading Labels & Nutrition



Demond Johnson

Demond Johnson introduced our speaker Allison Mankowski (MPH, RD, CSSD). Allison is a UM grad who currently works in sports nutrition at EMU. She is a subject matter expert on nutrition with a small private practice and she also consults with the Detroit Lions. Demond noted that cookies and doughnuts are not essential to a healthy diet.

Allison addressed the ins and outs of reading nutrition labels on packaged food and beverages and told us how the different quantity and quality values interact in our bodies to control diabetes, promote heart health, provide energy, and an overall better quality of life. Here are a few highlights from her very informative talk:

- Line One, Serving Size—the quantity of food that contains the values listed. You can estimate serving size using your hand(s).
- Line Two, Calories—come from carbohydrates (which provide short-term energy), protein (muscle repair and growth), fat (long-term energy, insulation, and protection). Needs vary by age, sex, and activity level with average of about 1,600-2,400 calories per day.
- Line Three, Fat—types are saturated from animal products, unsaturated from plant products, and trans added to processed food. The best fats are minimally processed. Not so good are fats from desserts, creamy dressing/sauces, processed meats, and fried foods. Quantity matters, think low or high but don't think none. ~Continued on Page 5.

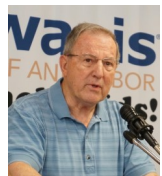

TODAY'S PROGRAM CONTINUED FROM PAGE 1...

- Lines Four & Five, Cholesterol and Sodium—think low.
- Line Six, Carbohydrates—come from fiber, natural sugar, added sugar. Look for high in fiber. Limit added sugar to less than 10% of daily calories, focus on minimally processed carbs such as oatmeal, beans, potatoes, rice, other grains. Limit processed carbs such as white bread, snacky items, and pre-packaged meals.
- Line Seven, Protein—comes from animal products such as meat, dairy, eggs, and plant products such as beans, nuts/seeds, and whole grain. Need about .4 grams per pound of body weight per day. High protein/high carb food is good because it lasts longer during the day.
- Other Micronutrients—vitamins and minerals help with many body functions. Best from fresh vegetables high in micronutrients, the more colors the better, flash frozen is OK, steam not boil.

Q. Is high body metabolism just genetic?
 A. Complicated but better nutrition and more muscle means higher metabolism.

Q. How are calories on labels calculated?
 A. Loose guidelines so calorie content is estimated.

Q. Sugar substitutes?
 A. Natural sugar is better.

Thanks Allison, we are what we eat.

NEW HVAC UNITS INSTALLED...

- Large 60 Ton dysfunctional HVAC unit hauled off for scrap metal
- Two smaller dysfunctional units also removed from roof with crane
- Two 20 Ton HVAC units were lifted and placed on roof deck
- Holes in roof were covered and new duct work inside for new units
- One of the two new units will heat and cool Rm 1100 (clothing, linens, shoes and infants ware)
- One of the two new units will heat and cool Rm 1300 (seasonal furniture, office furniture and vintage toy area)
- Work is continuing on the installation and calibration of the new units
