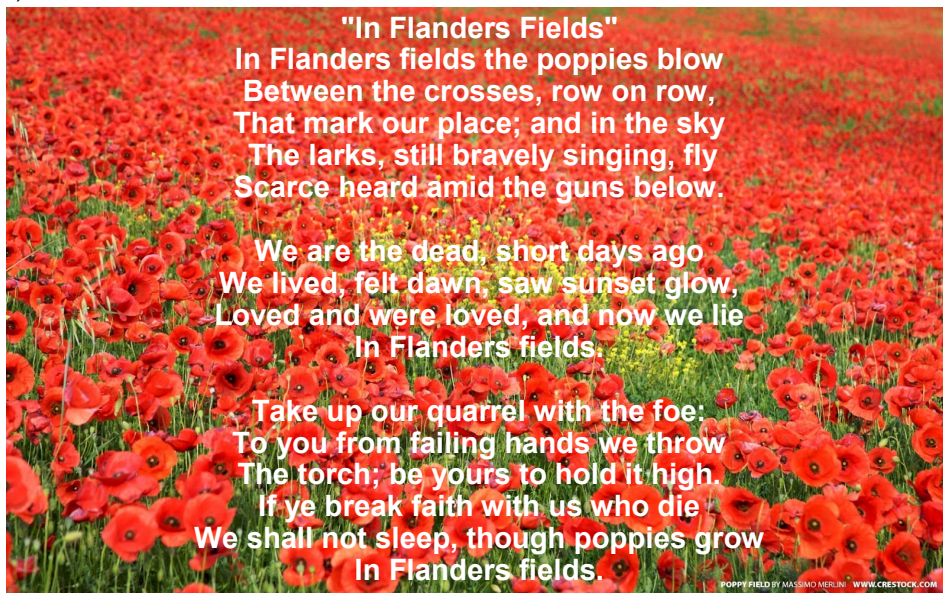

His latest project is the First Responders Salute for all of Washtenaw County (public not invited), Honored by Military Veterans, to be held at the VFW Post 423 at 3230 S. Wagner Rd. on Saturday, June 16 from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. This event will celebrate all the first responders and retirees of Washtenaw County, police, fire, and EMS workers.
