#### GENESIS: Cross & Star of David

Dick Benedek introduced speakers Rabbi Josh Whinston of Temple Beth Emeth and Christine Moody, who is a member of St. Clare of Assisi Episcopal Church. They are both involved with Genesis, the 501c3 organization that owns the property located at 2309 Packard shared by the church and temple. A Cross and Star of David are side by side on the building. This may be the only building in the United States that was jointly designed and built by two different religions. The facility was com-

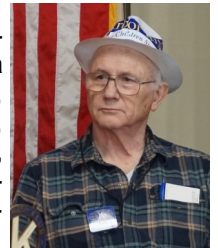

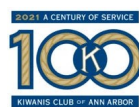
