TODAY'S PROGRAM...

The KEEP

Margaret Krasnoff introduced Shannan Gibb-Randall and Lindsey Nelson of Insite Design. They are both landscape architects who have been advising us on the KEEP (Kiwaniis Environmental Education Preserve). They have been working with the KEEP Committee and shared some of their ideas and designs which included slides of the property going back to 1960.

We learned that a river runs through the KEEP, or at least Honey Creek does. The property includes wet lands, invasive species, and lots of deer and mosquitoes. They said that parts of the KEEP need healing and discussed a preliminary master plan which could include a deer wall, a controlled burn, signage, guardrails, and a classroom area. The KEEP is a great resource with a lot of potential, and we should be able to use it for some of our own uses, like picnics or educational uses.

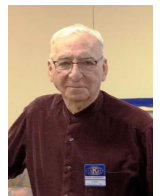
- The Board at its Special Meeting on Monday, March 12 approved a series of motions, as summarized below:

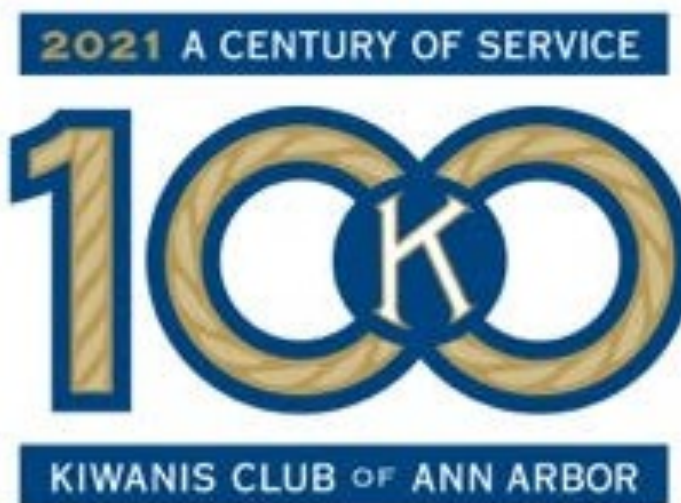
