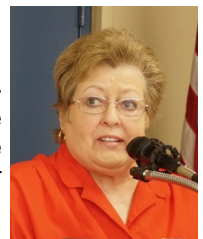


PROSPECTIVE MEMBER...

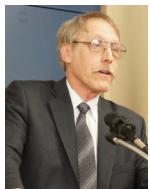

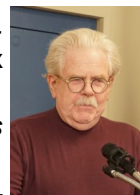

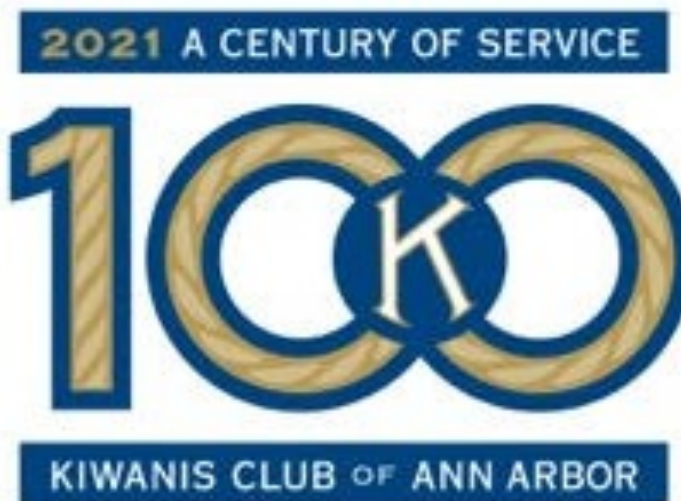
