TODAY'S PROGRAM...

Ele's Place

Jim Wolfington introduced today's speaker, **Monica Brancheau**, the Manager and Director of Ele's Place. Ele's Place was started in Lansing, MI in 1989 by Betsy and Woody Stover after their 11 month old daughter Ele died. They found that their surviving children were grieving in a much different manner than they were as adults. Realizing they didn't really know how to help their kids, they looked for local peer to peer support groups and found nothing. With the help of the Dougy Center of Portland, OR, the only center of this type at the time, they started Ele's Place in the basement of a Lansing Church.

Ele's Place, "a healing center for grieving children and teens" is just that; a place for children and teens to come together to learn how to understand, accept, and cope with the death of a parent or sibling. Whether expected or sudden, a loss of this kind is devastating to a family in many ways. Being with peers and knowing they aren't alone in this struggle is precisely what these kids need to start healing. Ms Brancheau noted that most of these kids don't have this support with their own friends because their friends don't understand the true impact of such a loss, expecting them to "get over it". Services are aged-based and the kids are taught how to express their grief in creative ways that allow them to also celebrate and remember the joy this person brought to their lives. Ele's Place also offers services to the adults in the family, who meet alone while their kids are meeting.

They now have four branches where they've helped over 26,000 families and meet with an average of 100 families a week. They also offer Ele's Group, an eight week school-based program. This is all done with the help of 150 active volunteers and, most important, this is all offered FREE to any family who has suffered a loss. Sadly, a recent study found that 1 in 12 children in Michigan will lose a parent or sibling before the age of 18 so this service is very much needed.

Ms Brancheau thanked us for the grant awarded to Ele's Place to support Ele's Group and we thank her for speaking to us today about this very difficult topic. It takes special people to work in this capacity and our continued support can help them bring healing to those least able to help themselves. You can find out more at www.elesplace.org.

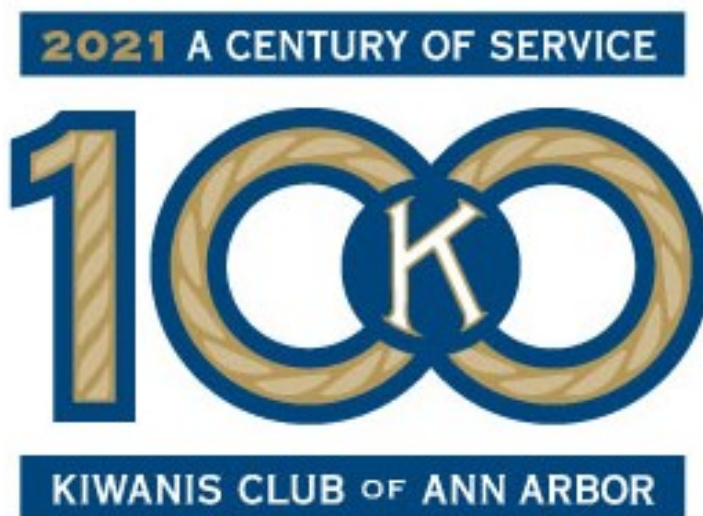
