Deb Jones introduced our speaker Mike Price, a John Maxwell Certified Speaker and the founder of Mike Price Training Solutions, a company dedicated to the development of individuals and organizations by creating and executing customized leadership strategies.

Mike discussed the 5 Levels of Leadership. At the first level, people follow because they have to. At the second level, they follow because they want to. At the third level they follow because of what the leader has done for the organization he or she is leading. At the fourth level they follow because of what the leader has done for them personally. And when the fifth level of leadership is attained, people follow because they respect who the leader is and what he or she represents.

He stressed that a person can in fact be a leader even without an official title, and that merely having a title does not make a person an actual leader. 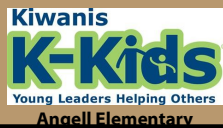
