TODAY'S PROGRAM...

THE MICHIGAN NATIONAL GUARD



Doris and Tom Granum

Doris and Tom Granum from First Presbyterian Church in Ann Arbor opened our patriotic program with Doris singing "The Battle Hymn of the Republic", accompanied by her husband Tom. Tom is the Director of Music Ministries at First Pres.

Dick Benedek then introduced our guest speaker, Col. John Wojcik, who came to speak about the Michigan National Guard. Col. Wojcik has served in the military for 28 years, mostly with the Michigan National Guard. Trained as a lawyer, he worked in private practice and served in the National Guard. After "9-11", however, Col. Wojcik left civilian life to serve as General Counsel for the Michigan National Guard.

We watched a brief video of the Michigan National Guard in action, carrying out its three fold mission: "Warfight, Homeland, Global Partnerships". Michigan National Guard troops have been deployed to Iraq and Afghanistan as ordered by the Federal Government. They also are called to duty by the Governor to help in situations calling for more security and support for local police. Third, the National Guard builds global partnerships through joint training and providing relief and support after hurricanes or other natural disasters.

We were invited to imagine the challenge of working a full time job, plus training with the Guard one weekend per month and two weeks at Camp Grayling for full fledged combat training. There are 11,000 men and women serving in the Michigan National Guard.

The program closed with more patriotic songs sung by Doris Granum, accompanied by Tom. It was a stirring program and in keeping with Independence Day. The editor hopes everyone had a pleasant Fourth of July and spent some time being thankful for our freedom and for those who serve to protect it.
