**Mission:** To provide adults living with disabilities an opportunity to develop initiative, leadership skills and to serve their communities.

-*Inclusiveness:* Accepting and welcoming differences in other people

-*Caring:* The act of being concerned about or interested in other people or situations

The Aktion Club members and their adult supervisors plan to participate in activities ranging from a UNICEF collection on Halloween, Bowl-A-Thons, Tree Plantings, building Bird Houses and developing Gardens. 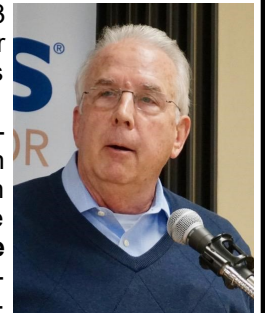
