Community Impact Report Fiscal Year 2024 (FY24)

Who is the Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor?

- We are Members, Volunteers, and Staff who help children, youth, families, & our community.
- September 30, 2024, the Kiwanis Club and Foundation of Ann Arbor had 147 members, 137 volunteers, and 12 full-time and 4 part-time staff. In FY24 we provided over 55,259 volunteer hours. Our Club was chartered in 1921 and our Foundation in 1965. Our Thrift Sale opened in 1927.

KIWANIS FOUNDATION THRIFT SALE is open **FRIDAYS** 9am to 1pm and **SATURDAYS** 9am to 3pm, except some holidays and weather permitting.

DROP OFF DONATIONS are on Saturdays only – 9am to 1:30pm.

Proceeds from the Kiwanis Foundation Thrift Sale, Gifts from our Members, and the Work of our Volunteers and Staff Benefit Our Community.

Since 1921 over \$12,941,500.

In FY24, Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor Foundation distributed over \$1,609,000.

- \$677,092 to support Local Children and Family Agencies and Services through our annual Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor Foundation GRANTS and Budget Process. (See list other side.)
- \$127,916 in Kiwanis “Finish Line” SCHOLARSHIPS to 34 Washtenaw Community College students.
- \$140,123 in Kiwanis VOUCHERS for Free Household Goods to 522 Families.
- \$491,123 in DIRECT GIFTS of Free Furniture and Merchandise to 72 Local Nonprofit Organizations.
- \$34,790 for Student Leadership Programs, Kiwanis Mich Foundation, and children’s hospitals.
- \$113,845 as WARM THE CHILDREN’S Official Sponsor, giving 1,216 children new winter clothing.
- \$17,644 via SALVATION ARMY’S Annual Bell Ringing campaign in December 2023.
- \$6,500 in INTERNATIONAL GRANTS to Haiti Nursing Foundation.

 - **MEALS ON WHEELS:** delivered over 6,422 meals last year.

 - **Kids Coalition Against Hunger 10,000 meals. Increased REUSE and RECYCLE services.**
 - **Prepared “Cooking Up Comfort” meals 8 times at Ronald McDonald House at UM hospital.**
 - **Supported 2 Dementia Friendly shopping days at our Kiwanis Thrift Sale.**
- \$134,590 provided by members over the last 14 years to the Haiti Nursing Foundation.
- \$104,905 provided by members over 5 years in a shared effort with UNICEF and our Kiwanis International to Eliminate Maternal Neonatal Tetanus (MNT) across the world.

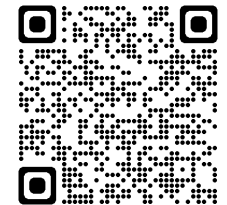
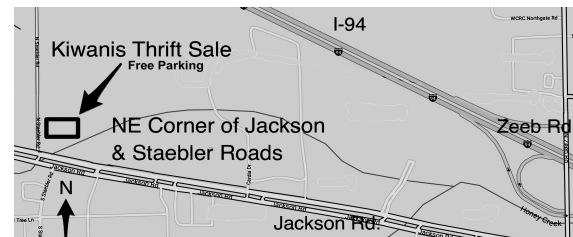
