FY25 = October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2025

Who is the Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor?

- We are Members, Volunteers, and Staff who help children, youth, families, & our community.
- September 30, 2025, the Kiwanis Club and Foundation of Ann Arbor had 139 members, 239 volunteers, 8 full-time and 9 part-time staff. In FY25 we provided 67,992 volunteer hours. Our Club was chartered in 1921 & our Foundation in 1965. Our Thrift Sale opened in 1927.

KIWANIS FOUNDATION THRIFT SALE is open **FRIDAYS** 9am to 1pm and **SATURDAYS** 9am to 3pm, except some holidays and weather permitting.

DROP OFF DONATIONS are on Saturdays only – 9am to noon.

Located at 100 N. Staebler Rd. Suite C, just off the NE corner of W. Jackson Rd. One mile west of Zeeb Rd. and One mile east of Baker Rd.

Proceeds from the Kiwanis Foundation Thrift Sale, Gifts from our Members, and the Work of our Volunteers and Staff Benefit Our Community.

Since 1921 over \$14,287,000.

In FY25, Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor Foundation distributed **\$1,346,000.**

\$118,787 in Kiwanis "Finish Line" SCHOLARSHIPS to 35 Washtenaw Comm College students.

\$136,190 in Kiwanis VOUCHERS for Free Household Goods to 722 Families.

\$339,739 in DIRECT GIFTS of Free Furniture and Merchandise to 50 Nonprofit Organizations.

\$75,163 for Student Leadership Programs, Kiwanis Mich Foundation, children's hospitals.

\$121,489 as WARM THE CHILDREN'S Official Sponsor, new winter clothing for 1,300 children.

\$14,782 via SALVATION ARMY'S Annual Bell Ringing campaign in December 2024.

\$5,925 in INTERNATIONAL GRANTS to Haiti Nursing Foundation.

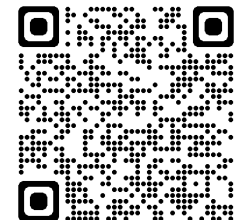
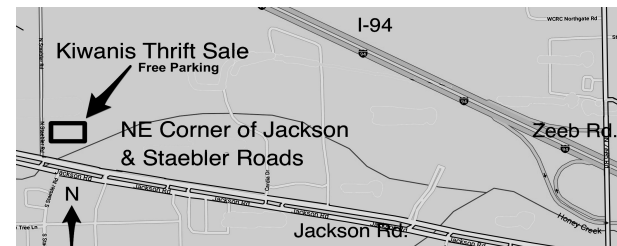
